

**Brunswick County Republican Party  
2012 Report of the Plan of Organization Committee**

**Overview:**

The 2012 Plan of Organization Committee was created by the Brunswick County Republican Party in accordance with the 2011 Brunswick County Republican Party Plan of Organization. The Committee Chair was appointed by Chairman George Bell. The Committee consists of Helen Pannullo, Chair; David Allardyce, and Holly Biasi.

The Committee conducted its business via email and telephone. The Committee recommends the following amendments to maintain the required consistency with the North Carolina Republican Party's Plan of Organization, adopted in June 2011.

**1. Article IV. A. 4. c. (page 8):**

Current:

c. The County Convention shall elect 1 Delegate and 1 Alternate to Congressional District and State Conventions, plus 1 additional Delegate and Alternate for every 250 Republicans, or major fraction thereof, registered in that county, as of January 1 of that year.

Proposed:

c. The County Convention shall elect 1 Delegate and 1 Alternate to Congressional District and State Conventions, plus 1 additional Delegate and Alternate for every 250 Republicans, or major fraction thereof, registered in that county, as of January **31** of that year.

**2. Article IV. A. 4. e. (page 8):**

Current:

e. If Brunswick County has been divided between 2 or more Congressional Districts, it shall prorate its Delegate vote among these Congressional Districts in accordance with the Republican registration as of January 1 of that year in the political subdivisions within the County which have been divided among the different Congressional Districts.

Proposed:

e. If Brunswick County has been divided between 2 or more Congressional Districts, it shall prorate its Delegate vote among these Congressional Districts in accordance with the Republican registration as of January **31** of that year in the political subdivisions within the County which have been divided among the different Congressional Districts.
